Painting

Acrylic, Gouache, Oil, & Watercolor

Session I June 14 - July 2 Children MW 9-11, Adults MW 12-4

Session II July 5 - July 30 Children MW 9-11, Adults MW 12-4

Painting is designed for the beginner to intermediate level as well as advanced painters who wish to hone skills and/or experiment with different media. The student may concentrate to paint in one medium or many. Focus is on Plein Air and direct drawing with brush on canvas rather than copying from photographs and grid planning. A variety of techniques are covered to assist the student in discovering what works and developing a personal style.

Digital, Film, & Slide

Beginning Photography is for the novice or hobbyist wishing to learn how to improve composition and take better photographs. Basic techniques, history, light, color, and subject are covered. Students may use any type of camera, digital, film or slide. Though digital methods are emphasized in class, students are encouraged to experiment with film and slides. Instruction on archiving, storage, & digital darkroom procedures included.

Silk Painting

Beginning June 12 & 13 All ages Sa 10-3, Su 12-3

Intermediate August 7 & 8 All ages Sa 10-3, Su 12-3

Basics and advanced techniques in painting directly on silk fabric. Students create wearable art scarves, handkerchiefs, blouses, bags, hats, ties, etc. Non-steam heat set method is utilized for a finished artwork that is colorfast and hand washable. Intermediate class focuses on color mixing, application, and special effect techniques such as salt application layering, and tie-dye.



Plein Air

Plein Air painting is a 2-day guided practice for beginning, intermediate and advanced artists interested in honing skills of quick sketch with brush, use of color, and composition of natural, cultivated, architectural and urban landscapes using a variety of media. Figure Painting available.

Pinnacles Weekend is a 2-day exclusive workshop for beginning, intermediate and advanced artists located in one of the most spectacular landscapes in California. Artists interested in honing skills of quick sketch with brush, use of color, and composition of natural and cultivated landscapes using a variety of painting media will benefit from this series of guided exercises & independent study.
